Update on Backpack Programme for the Southwest Detention Centre – Ten more backpacks were delivered last week and are greatly appreciated. We will need about 80-100 backpacks for the coming 12 months. This is the time to get them; Walmart, Staples and Dollar stores have the size we use, at about \$6-8 each. If you are feeling called to support this ministry for St. Matthew's, you can participate by purchasing backpacks yourself, or by donating, using the envelopes at the entrance to the church. Other items we need for men and women: underwear (medium and large sizes); socks (darker colours don't show dirt; thicker for winter; thinner OK for summer); hats, scarves and gloves (thick ones needed); towels and washcloths (regular bath size, not hand towel or bath sheet, please); toiletries (deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste); tissues (purse size – NOT big boxes); toilet paper (double size rolls preferred); shampoo (travel size – unused please).
