Dear St. Matthew's family,

It has been a long and challenging several months since we last met for inperson worship, so it is with pleasure that I announce that Bishop Todd has authorized the re-opening of all churches in the Diocese of Huron. As we reopen St. Matthew's as of today, with our Sunday worship services at 8:30 AM and 10:00 AM, all of the following health protocols will be in place:

- 1. A limit of 45 persons per service. We will not be taking advance registration; however, you will be asked to sign in (name and phone number) upon arrival.
- 2. A shorter liturgy (no longer than 45 min.)
- 3. Doors and windows will be open. The ceiling fans and air conditioning will not be in use during services.
- 4. We will maintain our practices of physical distancing, frequent hand washing/use of sanitizer, mask wearing (except for children under age 2, or for people who have health conditions that prevent them from wearing face coverings).
- 5. At this time, there will be no congregational singing.
