Gilles+, receive these books and be among us as a leader of prayer.

Priest: May our common prayers rise up to God's presence.

Mary Davis and Louise Davis present the Canons of the Diocese.

Gilles+, receive these canons and be among us as a pastor and priest.

Priest: With the help of God, I will build up the flock of Christ.

Luiz Montebello presents the oil.

Gilles+, use this oil and be among us as a healer and reconciler.

Priest: May I be an instrument of God's peace.

Obianuju Onuegbu (Uju) presents the water.

Gilles+, receive this water and baptize in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Priest: I will baptize in obedience to the Lord's command.

Susan Trenhaile and Margaret Jemison present bread and wine.

Gilles+, take this bread and wine and be among us to break the bread and bless the cup.

Priest: May it be our joy to go to the altar of God.

Archdeacon: Gilles+, let all these be the signs of the ministry which the Bishop shares with you in this parish.
